TOWN BOARD TOWN OF SULLIVAN REGULAR MEETING July 1, 2020 6:00 PM

A regular meeting of the Town Board of the Town of Sullivan was convened by Supervisor John Becker at 6:00 pm on July 1, 2020.

The meeting was noticed in accordance with Town Law and applicable NYS Executive Orders, to include utilization of the Zoom videoconferencing platform and YouTube streaming services.

HIGHWAY DISCUSSION

Supervisor Becker opened discussion on the 2020 Highway budget and the plans for purchasing new equipment while staying within the current 2020 budget. Two rollers are being purchased, which were authorized at the June 17, 2020 meeting. A request was received from Highway on purchasing a new excavator, along with an update on the CHIPS and paving roads within the Town.

The below was discussed and agreed upon:

#1) The rollers - one for \$17,000.00 and one for \$6,500.00. These will be paid under the following budgeted lines:

DB5110.2 - \$17,000.00 DA5142.4 - + 6,500.00 Total: \$23,500.00

#2) For the request to put out for bidding tonight, for bid opening on August 5, 2020 for an excavator:

Anticipated cost: \$170,000.00

Subtracting 3 months of lease

At 5,800.00 = 17,400.00: - 17,400.00

Balance of purchase: \$152,600.00

To be paid out of DA5130.2 (\$150,000.00) and DA5142.4 (\$2,600.00)

#3) To date in paving (6/30/2020) has been paid for out of DB5112.2:

All bids received pursuant to this notice will be publicly opened on August 5, 2020 at 6:00 P.M. at the Town Hall and considered at its regular meeting of the Town Board on the same date.

It is a condition of this bid that the equipment be delivered to the Town of Sullivan Highway Department.

Additional specification forms for this item may be obtained at the Town of Sullivan Town Hall, Attn: Supervisor's Office, 7507 Lakeport Road, Chittenango, New York 13037 or the Town of Sullivan Highway Department located at 7500 Bolivar Road, Chittenango, New York 13037.

All bids must be accompanied by a certificate executed pursuant to Section 103-d of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York. These Certificates are available from the Town Clerk. Be further advised that the Town Board may consider any bid which provides the Town with the "best value" as determined under Local Law 1 of 2014 and shall consider the following factors:

- 1. Lowest cost and convenience of maintenance or service of the equipment;
- 2. Durability and quality of the equipment;
- 3. Overall economic present and future value. Such factors may be evaluated by any submitted materials offered by the responsive bidder, as well as independent research by the Town of Sullivan.
- 4. Highest resale value.

The Town of Sullivan reserves the right to waive any and all irregularities and to reject any and all bids or to rebid solely at the Town Board's discretion

<u>UPDATE ON BRIDGEPORT STREETSCAPES PROJECT</u>

Supervisor Becker informed the Board visited the Bridgeport Streetscapes Project that is currently under construction in Bridgeport, for the purposes of Community Beautification. Councilor Ranger stated this project began in 2016 and in 2020 it is almost completed. Councilor Ranger thanked the Highway Department for their work on the project. Highway Superintendent Busa stated that along with engineers, it was decided to put a mix of stone and mulch, instead of all mulch within the drainage retention areas. The maintenance on this project will be the responsibility of the Highway Department. Supervisor Becker will also reach out to local groups in the area to inquire if they wish to help out with annual maintenance on the new Community Beautification Project.

BUDGET MODIFICATION FOR BRIDGEPORT STREETCAPES PROJECT

For the Bridgeport Streetscapes Project GIGP #1383 SRF Project Number: C7-6292-07-00 grant award amount totaling \$800,000.00, the following budget modifications (3) are necessary:

1) Transferring \$33,216.73 from A3097 St Aid Capital Projects to A8030.460 Engineering. This is for requisition #4 on Bport Streetscapes GIGP 1383. All engineering fees paid to B&L & Walker Tree-for tree replanted at Church. Original amount turned into EFC was \$38,850.00 EFC paid us \$33,216.73.
