There are other homes in the area with similar closeness to the road. This application was declared by the Board to be a Type II Action for SEQR.

A motion was duly made by Member Reals, seconded by Member Keville and unanimously passed by the Board granting 14 feet of relief from the front property line to build a 16' x 32' addition to the home.
